Senior Policy Analyst

Reporting to the Executive Vice President – Policy, the Senior Policy Analyst takes a lead role in developing and communicating policy positions and research across a range of areas of interest to the Business Council, including environment/climate change, energy issues, electricity, transportation, infrastructure, regional governance and other topics as required.

Major Duties and Responsibilities

1. Represent the Business Council and undertake research on environmental policy issues, including climate change and other provincial/regulatory issues (e.g., air quality, contaminated sites, water issues, etc.). Manage the Council's Environment Committee.
2. Represent the Business Council and undertake research on energy issues of interest to the membership (including oil and gas and electricity). Manage the Council's Task Force on Energy Policy.
3. Represent the Business Council and undertake research on transportation and infrastructure issues.
4. Organize and co-chair Environment Policy Advisory Group and Energy Policy Task Force meetings.
5. Prepare submissions, reports, presentations, and comment pieces.
6. Liaise with members and external stakeholders.
7. Represent the Business Council at outside events as required.

Desired Qualifications

- Master's degree (likely in economics, public policy, or environmental studies). We will also consider applicants with a legal background.
- **At least 5-10 years of relevant professional work experience**
- Excellent writing and research skills
- A strong interest in, and understanding of, public policy
